Action:	Since the fan has blades of reversed pitch, to maintain the same direction of air flow the direction of rotation must be reversed. Therefore, when fitting the new fan, which is interchangeable with the earlier one, the motor connections to the fan relay must be reversed to conform with Fig.1 By operating the heater/cooling switch on the facia, check that the airflow is correct, i.e. is blown onto the front wheel.						

The new fan is easily distinguished from the earlier one by the shape of


